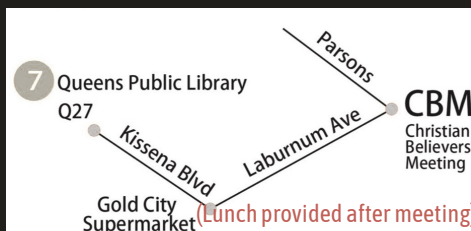

What is truth?

Dear Friend,

We are a group of Christians who deeply care about the destiny of your soul. If you have a few minutes when you receive this gospel invitation, we encourage you to take a moment to read and reflect on it. If you are busy or on the go, please save it and read it when you have the opportunity. Throughout the ages and across every culture, countless people have been deceived by sin. Many proudly regard themselves as the standard of truth, yet become consumed by the pursuit of fame, wealth, and power, and are ensnared by error, deception, falsehood, and self-righteousness. Like the morning dew or passing clouds, human glory appears only for a moment before vanishing away. Others have looked to philosophy, scientific discovery, or artistic inspiration as the highest truth. Yet these, though valuable in their own place, cannot reveal the eternal truth of the Creator. They are like the spray of the waves, ever moving and searching, yet never able to grasp the solid rock that endures forever.

More than two thousand years ago, because God so loved the world, He sent His one and only beloved Son, Jesus Christ, who declared, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. It contains more than 1,800 prophecies, including approximately 360 concerning the coming, death, resurrection, and redemptive work of Jesus Christ. The overwhelming majority of these prophecies have already been fulfilled, revealing the faithfulness and glory of God's truth.

With heaven and earth as His testimony, God declares that He is the Lord of life—the One who creates, redeems, and judges. It has often been said that a great reward was once offered to anyone who could disprove the truth of the Bible, yet no one has ever succeeded. Generations rise and fall like the tides, but the truth of Scripture remains unshaken. Jesus Christ is the one and only beloved Son of God, and He Himself is the Truth.

The Lord Jesus also said, "The truth shall make you free."
